
	WOOL MARKET MOVEMENTS
•	Sales were spread over three days with the EMI making small
	gains each day to close at 1,132 c/kg clean, up 7 cents. The
	national offering shrank 3,499 bales to 35,405 with just 4.8%
	(down 4.7%) passed in. The Merino fleece and crossbred sectors
	provided the positive impetus this week with little change in
	Merino skirtings or oddments. Sales resume Tuesday and
	Wednesday next week with 36,573 bales on offer.

- Mixed results in Sydney's Merino fleece sector on Tuesday. Stylish (MF3) lots, free from VM with good strength (> 40 N/ktex) were keenly sought. Lots with low strength and heavy VM were discounted. Further price gains in broader (≥ 18 μm) MPGs occurred on Tuesday, with length and strength measurements impacting price. No change to Merino skirtings on Tuesday before firming on Wednesday, especially superfine (< 16.5 μm) pieces with low (< 3%) VM. Crossbreds lifted 10 cents on Tuesday and were unchanged on Wednesday. No movement in oddments on Tuesday, before softening on Wednesday. Cardings were unchanged. The Northern Regional Indicator rose 7 cents to 1,169 c/kg clean as the Northern Merino Carding Indicator slipped 4 cents to 707 c/kg clean. Sydney's pass in rate was 4.2% with 396 bales withdrawn.</p>
- All Merino fleece MPGs, except the 17.5 μm which was unchanged, rose between 4 and 11 cents in Melbourne on Wednesday. Further gains (3 to 12 cents) occurred on Thursday, except the 16.5 μm MPG which shed 5 cents. Merino skirtings drifted lower (10 to 20 cents) on Wednesday before firming on Thursday. All crossbred MPGs lifted on Wednesday (up 5 to 15 cents), with nominal price movements on Thursday. Merino locks pushed the oddments sector higher on Wednesday as Merino lambs weakened. Minor price movements on Thursday. The Southern Regional Indicator lifted 8 cents to 1,108 c/kg clean with the Southern Merino Carding Indicator up 7 cents to 678 c/kg clean. Melbourne's pass in rate was 4.7% with 575 bales withdrawn.
- Fremantle's Merino fleece sector had a strong week. All MPGs closed either 20 or 23 cents higher. Low pass in rates were a feature. A small supply of finer (<18.5 µm) Merino skirtings with low (<3%) VM lifted 5 to 10 cents on Tuesday and maintained their ground on Wednesday. Locks jumped up to 35 cents for the week. Stains and crutchings lifted 10 to 15 cents on Tuesday and were unchanged on Wednesday. The Western Regional Indicator jumped 17 cents to 1,271 c/kg clean with the Western Merino Carding Indicator up 20 cents to 699 c/kg clean. Fremantle's pass in rate was 6.4% with 518 bales withdrawn.
